Exam	The exam consists our of an advice fort he
	case of your client (75%) and an oral
	presentation (25%) in which you have to
	convince your client about the solution you
	are proposing.
Caesura	A final score of 5,5 or higher leads to
	passing the course and receiving the related
	4 ECTS.
Retake exam	The retake of the exam is scheduled at the
