- Finally, you hear the entire dictation one more time

## Track 3


- At first, you will hear bar 1 and the first note of bar 2 three times, with 30 seconds in between

- Now, bar 3 and the first note of bar 4 three times, with 30 seconds in between
- Finally, you hear the entire dictation once more

## Intervals:

You will hear 5 intervals: each interval is played 3 times (with a break of 4 seconds in between): the first time broken, the second time unbroken and finally broken again.

- 1) Minor 6th
- 2) Tritonus (Aug. 4/Dim. 5) 3) Perfect 4th
- 4) Major 7th
- 5) Minor 3rd


# Triads:

The same with 5 triads: choose from major, minor, augmented and diminished, in root positon, first or second inversion:


- 1) Augmented
