

Erasmus+ Additional Scholarship

Erasmus+ aims to support all students that wish to take part in a study or internship abroad activity. There are additional scholarships for students with:

- Economic circumstance;
- Health circumstance.

Students that meet the requirements will be able to get an additional scholarship of €250 per month (or once an amount between €100 and €550 in case of a short-term mobility of max. 30 days, the amount depends on the travel distance and duration of the mobility).

Via Mobility Online you print, sign and upload a declaration on honour that confirms that at least one of these circumstances is applicable to you:

Economic circumstance:

- This is for students that:
 - ✓ are entitled to an additional scholarship (aanvullende beurs) from DUO;
 - ✓ or that are international Fontys students that by doing the [DUO calculation tool](#) learned they could be entitled to a supplementary grant from DUO.
- The height of the additional scholarship/supplementary grant does not matter. As long as it is not 0€.
- If your DUO support already stopped because you received it multiple years, you can still upload a letter from the period you did get the additional scholarship.
- It is not needed to upload this letter as proof. The signed declaration in Mobility Online is sufficient.

Health circumstance:

- You are able to get a letter of a doctor, a document with an official diagnosis, an extract of your health file that shows a circumstance or a declaration of a doctor that states that you have a situation that limits you in your behaviour (mentally or physically).
- It can be a disability (mental (intellectual, cognitive, learning), physical, sensory or other disabilities) but also chronic health problems (diabetes, dyslexia etc. etc.), severe illnesses or psychiatric conditions. There is no list and many situations apply.
- It is not needed to upload this letter as proof. The signed declaration in Mobility Online is sufficient.
