

Erasmus+ Additional Scholarship

Erasmus+ aims to support all students that wish to take part in a study or internship abroad activity. There are additional scholarships for students with:

- Economic circumstance;
- Health circumstance.

Students that meet the requirements will be able to get an additional scholarship of €250 per month (or once an amount between €100 and €550 in case of a short-term mobility of max. 30 days, the amount depends on the travel distance and duration of the mobility).

The type of proof for an additional scholarship depends on the circumstance. Please upload one of these two documents to your Mobility Online file.

Economic circumstance:

- Letter of DUO (Dutch Organisation for Education) where it shows that you are entitled to an additional scholarship (aanvullende beurs). Make sure your BSN-number is not visible due to privacy regulations.
- The height of the additional scholarship does not matter. As long as it is more than 0€.
- If your DUO support already stopped because you received it multiple years, you can still upload a letter from the period you did get the additional scholarship.
- We are aware of the fact that if you are not a student that gets support from DUO, you are excluded from this additional scholarship for this reason. Fontys is currently lobbying to widen the span of this Erasmus+ regulation, but at the moment this is the regulation we need to follow.

Health circumstance:

- Letter of Fontys Student Counciler (decaan) confirming a health circumstance. You should go to the student counciler walk-in hour for this matter, for the availability check their [website](#). The Counciler deals carefully with your privacy and they are not allowed to share your health circumstance with other Fontys staff for this matter.
- You need to show the Counciler a proof of your health circumstance. This can for example be a letter of a doctor, a document with an official diagnosis, an extract of your health file that shows a circumstance or a declaration of a doctor that states that you have a situation that limits you in your behaviour (mentally or physically).
- It can be disability (mental (intellectual, cognitive, learning), physical, sensory or other disabilities) but also chronic health problems (diabetes, dyslexia etc. etc.), severe illnesses or psychiatric conditions. There is no list and many situations apply, as long as the needed proof (see above) can be submitted.

If both the economic circumstance and the health circumstance apply to you, you only need to upload a proof for one of the two circumstances.

If you cannot provide the necessary documents you will have to refrain from this additional scholarship. In that case please upload a file with a text stating that you do not wish to apply for this additional scholarship, afterwards we will proceed in the Mobility Online process and proceed with the payment of the Erasmus+ scholarship without the additional scholarship.
