Art Lab is a research proposal based program. There is no division into different disciplines. The development of the artistic process is guiding for the choice of disciplines, techniques and materials. Each student is requested to write a research proposal that will be considered as a a starting point.

Students will be tutored by a multidisciplinary team of 5/6 professors. There will be an assessment after each trimester. Students are also expected to present their work, sources and working method to their companions regularly. Lessons and discussions are mostly in English, work discussions with exchange students always in English. Accessible for 3rd year students!
