

# General financial matters

- Personal budget;
  - Make a financial plan / budget for your period abroad;
  - Need a job (abroad)?
  - Need a loan?
  - Need to go for a shorter period?
- DUO (governmental support from Dutch government);
  - Apply for public transport support (OV-vergoeding) for the period abroad;
  - Apply for grant for students that do now live with parents (in case now you do).

You might get the Holland Scholarship.

- For education, youth(work) and sport;

## 33 programme countries

- 27 European Union countries;
- Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein;
- N-Macedonia, Turkey, Serbia;

New from spring 2023: some extra countries, worldwide

# How much money will you get?

- Basic Erasmus+ scholarship:

Amount per day	Countries
€ 12	Denmark, Finland, Norway, Sweden, Iceland, Ireland, Luxembourg, Liechtenstein
€ 10	Austria, Belgium, Germany, France, Italy, Greece, Spain, Cyprus, Malta, Portugal
€ 8	Bulgaria, Romania, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Hungary, Croatia, Serbia, Slovenia, Slovakia, Czech Republic, North Macedonia, Turkey

- Erasmus+ Additional scholarship:  
€8,33 per day on top off above-mentioned amounts (same for all countries)

# How much money will you get?

- Basic Erasmus+ scholarship:

Amount per month	Countries
€ 360	United Kingdom
€ 700	Chile, <b>India</b> , Japan, Mexico, South-Korea, South-Africa, <b>USA</b> + <b>€820</b> - €1500 travel costs

- Erasmus+ Additional scholarship:  
€8,33 per day on top off above-mentioned amounts (same for all countries)

**Only for specific partner universities of specific Fontys clusters**

# Conditions for scholarship



- Study abroad at an Erasmus+ partner university of Fontys;
  - Move to another country;
  - Study abroad for at least 2 months;
  - Maximum 360 days in total (incl. all Erasmus+ activities during Bachelor (incl. short-term Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programme participation and (graduation) internships);
- 
- Fontys has enough Erasmus+ budget to provide a scholarship to all students that meet these conditions.



## Regulations:

- Hand in your **complete** documents in time;
- Carefully read all instruction emails and check Mobility Online;
- Ask [studyabroad@fontys.nl](mailto:studyabroad@fontys.nl) for help in case of doubt;
- Be aware that you will be asked to pay back the scholarship if you don't follow the rules.

## Erasmus+ Additional Scholarship:

- On top of the regular Erasmus+ scholarship there are additional scholarships for students with:
  - Economic circumstance;
  - Health circumstance.
- Students that meet the requirements will be able to get an additional scholarship of €250 per month (€8,33 per day).
- There are no budget limits, all students that meet the criteria will get this additional scholarship.

▪ The sooner you apply and complete all documents, the faster you have the money on your bank account

▪ We take about 5 working days to check your documents and another 5 working days to transfer the money to your bank account

## Online Language Course:

- Obligatory language assessment (excl. native-speaker)
- Language of country of destination / or study language
- Free and voluntary course
- You can start as soon as your Erasmus+ application has been approved



## Erasmus+ for Green Travel:

- Will you use train, bus or carpool on your 2-way trip to your destination?
- For this you will get €50 extra Erasmus+ scholarship and if because of this your trip takes more time you can request up to 4 additional travel days.
- These additional travel days are added to your total number of scholarship days. The check and payment is done after your stay abroad.



## Blended Mobility:

- Blended mobility is planned prior to start of your activity;
- First have virtual mobility, and afterwards physical mobility (abroad);
- The physical part (abroad) should have a minimum duration of 2 months;
- Also if you work online from the host-country this counts as physical mobility (abroad);
- You only receive the Erasmus+ scholarship for the period you are actually abroad.


